

QUALIFYING AND DISQUALIFYING CRITERIA

Start by completing the form on [this page](#). After you submit it, our care team will contact you to review a short set of screening questions.

The questions are shared here so you know what we will be asking. You do not need to answer them online. Final eligibility is determined after a clinical review by our care team.

Basic eligibility questions

You must answer YES to all of the following:

- Are you between the ages of 45 and 70?
- Do you live in Broward County?
- Do you have active health insurance?

Risk factor questions

You may meet criteria if you answer YES to one or more of the following:

- Diabetes?
- High blood pressure?
- High cholesterol?
- History of smoking?
- Family history of coronary disease? (parent or sibling)

Medical history considerations

This screening may not be appropriate if you answer YES to any of the following:

- You have had a cardiac CT angiogram or calcium scoring exam within the past five years
- You have heart stents
- You have had open-heart or other cardiac surgery
- You currently have chest pain or shortness of breath
- You are receiving chemotherapy or immunotherapy for cancer
- You have received a solid organ transplant (heart, liver, or kidney)

In some situations, an alternate test such as a calcium scoring exam may be recommended.

What happens next?

If the screening appears appropriate, our team will schedule your screening.
